



Jean Srnecz Memorial Scholarship Fund

We honor the memory of Jean Srnecz, Senior Vice President of Merchandising for

Baker & Taylor, with this scholarship fund.

The fund is managed by the Baker & Taylor Foundation. Friends, family, publishers and coworkers have generously donated to this fund, which awards college scholarships to children of Baker & Taylor employees.

I. Participation Eligibility

A. Participation is restricted to natural legal-custodied children of active Baker & Taylor employees. Active employee is defined as a worker on the payroll the day the scholarship is awarded. The employee must have completed one year of continuous employment.

B. Recipient must be a high school senior who has been accepted at an accredited four-year college and is pursuing a four-year degree or a full-time college student.

C. The scholarship amount will be \$3,000.

D. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college or university of choice to apply toward tuition, room and board and other charges billed by the institution.

II. Restrictions

A. Scholarships are not renewable.

B. All applicants shall be considered on the basis of:

1. Merit
 - a. Academic ability
 - b. Leadership potential
 - c. Genuine interest in a career in chosen profession
2. Financial Need

C. Baker & Taylor executives' children are not eligible. Only children of employees at the Director level and below are eligible.

III. Procedures

A. Only children (see preceding definition) of Baker & Taylor employees are eligible.

B. Applications are available from Human Resources offices of all Baker & Taylor facilities.

C. Applicants should apply to:

D. Applicants will be considered only after having been officially accepted by the institution of their choice.

E. For an application to be considered, the committee must receive all of the following information:

1. Copy of the letter of acceptance from the institution or a copy of the upcoming term's bill.

2. If the student has completed less than one year of college, any or all of the following should be submitted: high school transcript, SAT test scores, and information about outstanding achievements, extracurricular activities and positions of leadership. If the student has completed one year or more of college, then a college transcript is required.

3. Letter stating applicant's interest and intentions of entering their chosen profession.

4. Completed Jean Srnecz Scholarship Fund Application.

IV. Selection Committee

A. Committee will be composed of individuals with no prior employment at Baker & Taylor Inc.

B. Committee members shall be chosen based on their general knowledge and interest in the welfare of the Baker & Taylor community at large.

C. Independent committee recommendations will be accepted without change by Baker & Taylor Foundation committee.
